# History of the Stations of the Cross

- Also known as “The Via Dolorosa” or “Way of Sorrows”
- Refers to the depiction of the final hours (or Passion) of Jesus, and the devotion commemorating the Passion.
- Tradition began with St. Francis of Assisi and extended throughout the Roman Catholic Church in the medieval period.
- Most commonly done during the Season of Lent, especially on Good Friday, and Friday evenings during Lent.
